- The Winter 2010 season starts on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2010
- The Club will run Winter 2010 leagues for the following (subject to entries):
  - ✓ Seniors Sunday                      Sundays                      5:30 pm – 10:00 pm
  - ✓ Masters (born pre 1980)              Sundays                      5:30 pm – 10:00 pm
  - ✓ Premier Men                              Mondays                      6.30 pm – 10:00 pm

(times are approximate and subject to change depending on number of entries and stadium availability)

- **REGISTRATIONS OPEN Friday 21<sup>st</sup> May 2010.** Online registrations are preferred – go to [www.ecisc.org.nz/registration.php](http://www.ecisc.org.nz/registration.php) and follow the instructions carefully
- **REGISTRATIONS WILL CLOSE AT MIDNIGHT MONDAY 7<sup>th</sup> JUNE - or earlier if leagues are full.** Late registrations allowed only where there are places available and subject to \$50 per team late registration fee
- Due to the demand for places PLEASE avoid disappointment - **REGISTER AND PAY FOR YOUR TEAM EARLY TO GUARANTEE A PLACE**
- Each team will need a “Team Organiser” to register and manage the team and be the point of contact for information from the Club

## REGISTRATION FOR WINTER 2010 LEAGUES

We accept registrations from teams. Squads can have a maximum of 10 registered players. Team organisers should register their teams online at [www.ecisc.org.nz](http://www.ecisc.org.nz) Click the “Registration” link for full details.

We cannot accept registrations from individuals but are happy to facilitate those wishing to get in touch with others to form teams. See the “Players Seeking Teams” section on the home page of the website.

## **AFFILIATION TO NEW ZEALAND FOOTBALL- FUTSAL**



The East City Club is an affiliated member of NZF-Futsal.

All correctly registered and financial members of East City will automatically be affiliated to the national body. Team registration fees have been increased slightly to assist in covering the per head affiliation levies that will be payable.

There are some exciting times ahead for the game with

- a full time Futsal Development Officer at NZF
- improved player development opportunities
- more Futsal providers
- regular regional and national competitions
- improved training and development of referees
- high level commitment to national representative teams etc

All players taking part in East City leagues need to be NZF-Futsal affiliated. Make sure your team organiser registers you correctly, and pays the team fees and we will do the rest. Player Registration cards will be issued to all players this season.

## **PREMIER MEN'S LEAGUE FOR ELITE LEVEL**

The Club is again offering an elite league for men, played on a full international sized court.

The standard of this league is high. The winning team will receive the Premier Cup and a \$300 credit toward their entry fee into a future Premier Men's League. The runners up will receive a \$150 credit.

The final composition of the league will be at the discretion of the Committee to ensure that all teams are of an appropriate standard for this competition. ## **LEAGUE INFORMATION – Winter 2010**

**PLEASE NOTE: – this information is given as a guide only and may need to be changed depending on the number of teams who register, stadium availability and demand on court space. If there are less than 4 teams in any one grade, those teams may be added to another grade. If the Club is unable to form a league for any age group due to lack of entries a full refund will be provided.**

## PLAYER DISPENSATIONS and REGISTRATION RESTRICTIONS

- Player's born after 1992 may play in Senior B, Masters or Premier grade only with written dispensation from the Committee. To apply, please email full details to [futsal@mandata.co.nz](mailto:futsal@mandata.co.nz) and include written evidence of parent/guardian approval.
- No underage players are allowed in the Masters league.
- An individual player may register in more than one team provided the appropriate fees are paid for each team; and the teams are in different grades and in appropriate age groups.
- Teams registering for the Senior leagues may not have more than two players who are also registered for a Premier Men's team in the same season.

***Fully paid up teams will be given preference in allocation of available places in leagues. Teams who are not fully paid may be excluded from leagues at the discretion of the Club Committee.***

## NEW MEMBERS

New members must provide proof of their date of birth (eg copy birth certificate, passport or driver's licence). Copies must be posted (P O Box 11 042, Ellerslie 1542) or emailed ( [futsal@mandata.co.nz](mailto:futsal@mandata.co.nz) ) and received no later than Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2010.

## PLAYER IDs

NZF-Futsal player ID cards will be available before the 4<sup>th</sup> game of the season. All players must be able to produce these on demand at any match thereafter.

## INFORMATION FOR FEMALE PLAYERS

Demand for all female leagues in recent seasons has been very limited. Accordingly no such leagues are being scheduled this season. The Club hopes to be in a position to offer all girls/women's leagues in future.

Female players are permitted in all leagues except Premier Men.

## JUNIOR/YOUTH LEAGUES

The Club is unable to offer junior/youth during the winter due to restricted court availability.

## RULES

The general rules of Futsal, plus specific club and league rules are updated regularly and published on our website [www.ecisc.org.nz/rules.php](http://www.ecisc.org.nz/rules.php). They are also circulated to all Team Organisers prior to commencement of leagues each season. All players are expected to have a reasonable understanding of the game and the special club/venue rules.

### **Some KEY RULES to remember:**

- **No abuse of opposition players, referees, linesmen or club officials will be tolerated.**
- **No shin pads – no play** (referees will be enforcing this rule for your safety and the safety of other players)
- **Maximum of 10 players per team per season.**
- **All players must be registered – player registrations must be completed prior to a team playing the third match of their league.**
- **Underage players are permitted in all leagues (except Masters) but must apply and be granted a dispensation by the Club. Written evidence of parental consent will be required for those 17 years or under wishing to play in a senior league.**
- **No underage players permitted in Masters (Over 30's)**
- **No ring ins are allowed**
- **No kicking or throwing of balls in ASB stadium except on courts**
- **No food on courts**
- **No water spillages** (wipe up immediately – a wet court is dangerous)
- **Only coaches/players to be on court or courtside** (all others upstairs)
- **Players should not wear jewellery of any description** (see rules)
- **Each team must play in matching strip (shirts, shorts and socks)**
- **Long pants are not permitted, except for the goalkeeper who must wear an alternative colour from the other players in their team.**
